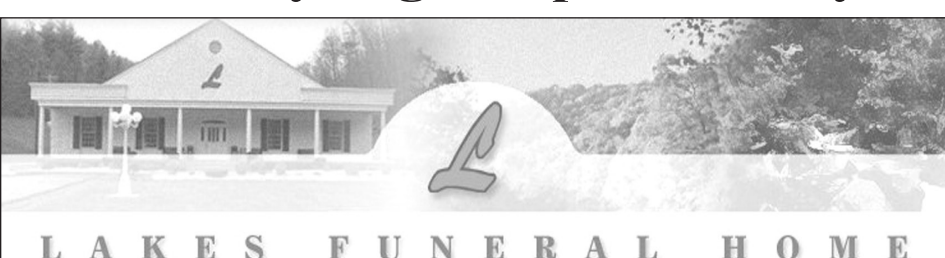

## Open Enrollment at Healthcare.gov Begins Nov. 1

FRANKFORT, KY. (Oct. 30, 2018) – Open Enrollment for 2019 Marketplace health insurance plans at healthcare.gov starts Thursday. The Kentucky Health Benefit Exchange (KHBE), within the Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS) is working to ensure Kentuckians are prepared, informed and have the resources they need to choose a 2019 health plan.

This year's open enrollment runs from Nov. 1 until Dec. 15 for coverage beginning January 1, 2019. Many Kentuckians who do not want to make changes to their plans will be automatically re-enrolled, but everyone is encouraged to check the status of their enrollment and selected coverage options. In many cases, policyholders will have the same plan for 2019 or their coverage will move from their current plan to an available 2019 option that most closely matches their current coverage.

CHFS is using a comprehensive campaign to reach current policyholders and potential new enrollees. These targeted efforts include direct mail, text messages, phone calls and email. Additionally, KHBE is coordinating with community assisters who service every county in the Commonwealth. Assisters and KHBE staff will be at community outreach events across the state. To find an event in your area or to locate an assistor near you, who can answer your questions and guide you through the application process, simply log on to: [healthbenefitexchange.ky.gov](http://healthbenefitexchange.ky.gov)

The state-based call center is available at 855-459-6328 to assist Kentuckians with questions about where to go for coverage. The call center can help prescreen for program eligibility and help with questions and information. The HealthCare.gov customer service center is also available. It can be reached by calling 800-318-2596. The healthcare.gov call center is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Current plan holders, and those who want to view 2019 options on the exchange, can now go to healthcare.gov and use the shopping tool. For new users, the federal marketplace requires the creation of a user account and a completed online application.
